



## Glacier Chaser Classic

### Futurity, Derby, Open 5D, Youth, Peewee and Senior Barrel Race

#### Rules and Regulations 2020

##### **\$9000 Added 2D Futurity**

1. The Futurity is open to any horse that is a foal of 2015 or younger. Horse must not reach the age of 6 during the 2020-year. A licensed veterinarian may mouth entries at the time of check in. The veterinarian's decision is FINAL.
2. To enter the futurity the horse must not have competed in a barrel race prior to November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019. This excludes time only or exhibition runs. Failure to comply with this rule means forfeiture of entry fees paid and elimination from futurity.
3. Name of the horse must be specified at the time of entry. If the horse is registered, a front and back copy of the registration papers must be submitted with the nomination payment. If the horse is unregistered, a veterinarian affidavit of year of birth and owners signature must accompany nomination payment. All money won will be paid to the registered owner of the horse unless written permission from the owner is received in advance. Owner's Social Security Number MUST be on the nomination form.
4. Futurity horses may only compete one year, either 3, 4, or 5 years of age. No cross entry with the Derby.
5. The futurity entry fee per horse is \$400 ALL IN US FUNDS  
    \$150 to nominate..... May 1<sup>st</sup>  
    \$150 to maintain..... June 1<sup>st</sup>  
    \$100 to maintain..... July 1<sup>st</sup>  
    \$400 Total Futurity Entry  
    **Absolutely No Refunds.** There will be a \$35 service charge on all returned checks.
6. Late nominations will be accepted with submission of payment and late fees. Nominations postmarked after June 1<sup>st</sup> will be assessed a \$50 late fee. Once nomination is made sustaining payment if received after July 1<sup>st</sup> will be assessed a \$75 late fee. All entries must be post marked on or before the designated due dates, regardless of Sunday or Holiday, Any entry postmarked later than July 1<sup>st</sup> will be in the late draw and assessed LATE FEES (\$125). No Entries will be taken after Friday July 10<sup>th</sup> at Noon. No exceptions.
7. Futurity will be paid out as follows. \$7500 to the 1D and \$1500 to the 2D w/ a full second split (no extra EF) \$325 EF for all fully paid horses goes to the futurity payout. All late, drop out and the \$75 Office fee will be retained by the committee. There will be two go-rounds and an average with each go paying 33.3% and 33.3% going to the average. Futurity champion will be determined by the average. In case of a tie, the fast time of the weekend will determine the champion.
8. Substitutions allowed. Substitution of horses due to injury, illness, death or sale of nominated horse with a veterinarian's affidavit will be allowed with a fee of \$75 by Noon on Friday the 10<sup>th</sup>. Substitutions must meet eligibility requirements. Substitution of rider due to injury, illness, death, or sale of nominated horse will be allowed with a \$75 fee by Noon Friday the 10<sup>th</sup>.
9. Buyouts allowed of futurity spot with a \$75 fee by Noon Friday the 10<sup>th</sup>.
10. A Knocked Barrel down will result in a .5 second penalty.
11. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a rerun and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked every 5 runs and big drags will be determined by the total entries.

12. Futurity runs will have the option to carry over to the Open 5D.
13. Future Fortunes has added \$10,000 to the Open in a 4D format with ½ second splits. Your horse must be eligible and nominated with the Future Fortunes program. You can visit their website at [futurefortunesinc.com](http://futurefortunesinc.com) All futurity/derby horses have the option to carry over the time from their event to the Open 5D races and through this carry option are then eligible for the Future Fortunes Open Bonus Money. The Future Fortunes program is a self-reporting program. It is the responsibility of the owner to indicate the horse is Future Fortune eligible and provides substantiating evidence. **ALL Future Fortunes Eligible Horses MUST submit a copy of the horse's papers showing current owner with entry and this must be marked on the entry form at time of entry.**
14. BBI Side pot. Open to any 4 or 5-year-old horse sired by a Barrel Breeders Incentive Stallion can qualify for bonus money in the BBI Side pots. Placing for the BBI Side pots is determined on the average of two goes in the futurity of the GCC. Entry fee for the BBI is \$50 and can be included in your GCC entry. 15. PESI BONUS MONEY To be eligible for PESI futurity bonus money, horse must be enrolled in PESI and rider must be a current WPRA member. FMI visit [www.wpra.com/pesi.asp](http://www.wpra.com/pesi.asp) Futurity will be paid on 2 go's.
16. DRESS CODE Cowboy hat or helmet, Long Sleeve Shirt, Western Pants, and Boots are required.

### **\$6000 ADDED 2D Derby**

1. Open to any horse foaled 2013-2015 (5 to 7) years of age.
2. Name of the horse must be specified at the time of entry. If the horse is registered, a front and back copy of the registration papers must be submitted with the nomination payment. If the horse is unregistered, a veterinarian affidavit of year of birth and owners signature must accompany nomination payment. All money won will be paid to the registered owner of the horse unless written permission from the owner is received in advance. Owner's Social Security Number MUST be on the nomination form.
3. The Derby Entry Fee Per Horse is \$300 ALL IN US FUNDS
  - \$100 to Nominate..... May 1<sup>st</sup>
  - \$100 to Maintain..... June 1<sup>st</sup>
  - \$100 to Maintain..... July 1<sup>st</sup>
  - \$300 Total Derby Entry Fee

**Absolutely No Refunds.** There will be a \$35 service fee on all returned checks.
4. Late nominations will be accepted with submission of payment and late fees. Nominations postmarked after June 1<sup>st</sup> will be assessed a \$50 late fee. Once nomination is made sustaining payment if received after July 1<sup>st</sup> will be assessed a \$75 late fee. All entries must be post marked on or before the designated due dates, regardless of Sunday or Holiday, Any entry postmarked later than July 1<sup>st</sup> will be in the late draw and assessed LATE FEES (\$125). No Entries will be taken after Friday July 10<sup>th</sup> at Noon. No exceptions.
5. Derby will be paid out as follows. \$5000 to the 1D and \$1000 to the 2D w/ a full second split (no extra EF) \$250 EF for all fully paid horses goes to the futurity payout. All late, drop out and the committee will retain substitution fees as well as \$50 office of the entry fee. Two go-rounds and an average with each go paying 33.3% and 33.3% going to the average. Futurity champion will be determined by the average. In case of a tie, the fast time of the weekend will determine the champion.
6. Substitutions allowed. Substitution of horses due to injury, illness, death or sale of nominated horse with a veterinarian's affidavit will be allowed with a fee of \$75 by Noon on Friday the 10<sup>th</sup>. Substitutions must meet eligibility requirements. Substitution of rider due to injury, illness, death, or sale of nominated horse will be allowed with a \$75 fee by Noon Friday the 10<sup>th</sup>.
7. Buyouts allowed of Derby spot with a \$75 fee by Noon Friday the 10<sup>th</sup>.
8. A Knocked Barrel down will result in a .5 second penalty.

9. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a rerun and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked every 5 runs and big drags will be determined by the total entries.
10. Derby runs will have the option to carry over to the Open 5D.
11. Future Fortunes has added \$10,000 to the Open in a 4D format with ½ second splits. Your horse must be eligible and nominated with the Future Fortunes program. You can visit their website at [futurefortunesinc.com](http://futurefortunesinc.com) All futurity/derby horses have the option to carry over the time from their event to the Open 5D races and through this carry option are then eligible for the Future Fortunes Open Bonus Money. The Future Fortunes program is a self-reporting program. It is the responsibility of the owner to indicate the horse is Future Fortune eligible and provides substantiating evidence. **ALL Future Fortunes Eligible Horses MUST submit a copy of the horse's papers showing current owner with entry and this must be marked on the entry form at time of entry.**
12. BBI Side pot. Open to any 5 to 7 year old horse sired by a Barrel Breeders Incentive Stallion can qualify for bonus money in the BBI Side pots. Placing for the BBI Side pots is determined on the average of two gos in the derby of the GCC. Entry fee for the BBI is \$50 and can be included in your GCC entry. 13. PESI BONUS MONEY To be eligible for PESI derby bonus money, horse must be enrolled in PESI and rider must be a current WPRA member. FMI visit [www.wpra.com/pesi.asp](http://www.wpra.com/pesi.asp) Derby will be paid on 2 gos.
14. DRESS CODE Cowboy hat or helmet, Long Sleeve Shirt, Western Pants, and Boots are required.

**\$250 Added Thursday Night Warm Up. \$500 Added Friday Night Race  
\$6000 Added Open 5D**

1. Open to all riders and horses. Riders may enter multiple horses.
2. Thursday Night Enter on Site \$35 per rider, Friday \$45 per rider, Saturday and Sunday \$67 entry fee per horse per day. May carry over to the Youth and Senior. \$10 Office per person Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
3. Pre enter deadline must be Post Marked by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Late entries taken each day until the last pre entered horse runs, with a \$15/late fee per person per day. All late entries will be in the late draw.
4. Open 5D will be paid out in the 5D format and be ½ second splits. All late, drop out and office fees will be sustained by the committee. Two go rounds with average awards. Open 5D champions will be determined by the average. In case of a tie, the fast time of the weekend will determine the champion.
5. A Knocked Barrel down will result in a no time.
6. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a rerun and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked every 5 runs and big drags will be determined by the total entries.
7. DRAW OUTS: 70% of entry fee refunds are available ONLY with a Veterinarians or Doctors release and MUST be received by 8am on the day of the race (Friday, Saturday or Sunday) Processing Fees (30%) as well as all Office and Late Fees are non refundable.
8. Future Fortunes (\$10,000) bonus money for eligible horses and their winnings will be paid directly by the respective organization. Must Specify FF eligible horses on entry form.
9. DRESS CODE Cowboy hat or helmet, Long Sleeve Shirt, Western Pants, and Boots are required.
10. Must run both days to qualify for average awards.
11. WPRA Co Approved Friday-Sunday/ UBRC Gunslinger Qualifier/ BBR Approved
12. Riders May Not Switch their horses' positions. Horses must run as they appear in the draw.

**Youth 4D \$800 Added**

1. Open to all riders 16 & under per the day of the event. May enter multiple horses.
2. \$47 Entry fee per horse per day. May be carried from Open 5D, futurity or derby.

3. Pre enter deadline must be Post Marked by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Late entries taken each day until the last pre entered horse runs, with a \$15/late fee per person per day. All late entries will be in the late draw.
4. Youth 4D will be paid out in the 4D format and be ½ second splits. All late, drop out and Office fees will be retained by the committee. Two go rounds with average awards. Youth 4D champions will be determined by the average. In case of a tie, the fast time of the weekend will determine the champion.
5. A Knocked Barrel down will result in a no time.
6. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a rerun and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked every 5 runs and big drags will be determined by the total entries.
7. DRAW OUTS: 70% of entry fee refunds are available ONLY with a Veterinarians or Doctors release and MUST be received by 8am on the day of the race (Friday, Saturday or Sunday) Processing Fees (30%) as well as all Office and Late Fees are non refundable.
8. DRESS CODE Cowboy hat or helmet, Long Sleeve Shirt, Western Pants, and Boots are required.

#### **Senior 4D \$800 Added**

1. Open to all riders 45 & Over per the day of the event. May enter multiple horses.
2. \$47 Entry fee per horse per day. May be carried from Open 5D, futurity or derby.
3. Pre enter deadline must be Post Marked by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Late entries taken each day until the last pre entered horse runs, with a \$15/late fee per person per day. All late entries will be in the late draw.
4. Senior 4D will be paid out in the 4D format and be ½ second splits. All late, drop out and office fees will be retained by the committee. Two go rounds with average awards. Senior 4D champions will be determined by the average. In case of a tie, the fast time of the weekend will determine the champion.
5. A Knocked Barrel down will result in a no time.
6. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a rerun and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked every 5 runs and big drags will be determined by the total entries.
7. DRAW OUTS: 70% of entry fee refunds are available ONLY with a Veterinarians or Doctors release and MUST be received by 8am on the day of the race (Friday, Saturday or Sunday) Processing Fees (30%) as well as all Office and Late Fees are non refundable.
8. DRESS CODE Cowboy hat or helmet, Long Sleeve Shirt, Western Pants, and Boots are required.

#### **Peewee 4D**

1. Open to all riders 8 & under per the day of the event. May enter multiple horses. MAY NOT COMPETE IN ANY OTHER EVENT
2. \$15 Entry fee per horse per day.
3. Pre enter deadline must be Post Marked by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Late entries taken each day until the last pre entered horse runs, with a \$15/late fee per person per day. All late entries will be in the late draw.
4. Peewee 4D will be paid out in the 4D format and be ½ second splits. 100% EF for all fully paid horses goes to Peewee 4D payout. All late, drop out fees will be retained by the committee. Two go rounds with average awards. Peewee 4D champions will be determined by the average. In case of a tie, the fast time of the weekend will determine the champion.
5. A Knocked Barrel down will result in a no time.
6. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a rerun and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked every 5 runs and big drags will be determined by the total entries.  
DRAW OUTS: 70% of entry fee refunds are available ONLY with a Veterinarians or Doctors release and MUST be received by 8am on the day of the race (Friday, Saturday or Sunday) Processing Fees (30%) as well as all Office and Late Fees are non refundable

7. DRESS CODE Cowboy hat or helmet, Long Sleeve Shirt, Western Pants, and Boots are required.

#### **GLACIER CHASER STALLION INCENTIVE 3D SIDEPOT**

1. The Glacier Chaser Stallion Incentive is a side pot open to eligible offspring of currently nominated stallions in which are running in the Futurity, Derby or Open.
2. Money will be paid out in a 3D format (fastest time out of all runs made) with ½ second splits, based on total eligible entries and money generated from the Glacier Chaser Stallion Auction that is held in January. A percentage will be paid to the Owner with a percentage going to the Stallion Owner. 100% of the \$20 entry fee money will be paid out.
3. Name of the horse must be specified at the time of entry. Horses must be registered and a front and back copy of registration papers must be submitted with the nomination payment. All money won will be paid to the registered owner of the horse unless written permission from the owner is received in advance. Owner's SSN must be on the entry form.
4. The Glacier Chaser Stallion Incentive Entry Fee is \$20 per horse.

#### **\$1000 Cash Target Race**

1. Open to anyone wanting to enter from the Open 5D, Youth 4D, senior 4D or Peewee 4D.
2. \$25 Entry fee per horse
3. The horse/rider combination with the two most similar times will be the winner based on Saturday & Sundays runs.
4. If there were a tie, the faster times of the weekend will be determined the winner.

1. The 2020 Glacier Chaser Classic will be held July 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> 2020 at the Majestic Valley Arena, 3630 US Hwy 93 N Kalispell, Montana 59901.
2. Stalls, Bedding & RV Hookups available on site. Please call Majestic Valley Arena to make reservations. 406-755-5366. Stall Cancellation Deadline June 29<sup>th</sup> @ 3pm for refund.
3. DRESS CODE Cowboy hat or helmet, Long Sleeve Shirt, Western Pants, and Boots are required for all events.
4. Electric Timer: Two Electric timers will be set up but in the event of malfunction competitors will be given a re run. If timers fail the contestant will be given the option of a re run and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked every 5 runs and big drags will be determined by the total entries.
5. Average Results will be posted every 50 racers. It is your responsibility to be available for awards or make your own arrangements. If you or your representatives are not present during awards ceremony, your prize will go to the next placing person.
6. Exhibitions will be sold on a first come first serve basis. They will be available for purchase online starting April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Link will be found on 2020 Glacier Chaser Classic Facebook Page. \$5 each. A one (1) minute time limit will be enforced for each one, if you fail to meet the time constraint you will be assessed a fine of \$20 for each instance.
